What is a reasonable meeting length and frequency for the Coordinating Group?

- Couple of hours every 3 to 4 weeks.

- Like having the task teams meeting prior to TSCG and then reporting back. 1 hour task team and 45 larger every 3 weeks.
- Monthly meetings face to face, with a zoom 1 hour meeting in between.
- Two weeks - 2 hours with task teams first
- Having the task teams meet the first hour and then TSCG .
- Monthly is the reasonable choice.
- Hope we get to monthly and for 2 hours
- Really like to see every two weeks held to the 90 minutes
- Preference is that the task team is independent of the TSCG.
- Let the task team start working and then bring it back to the TSCG when they are ready.
